

AGREEMENT BETWEEN ORGANIZER AND CONTESTANT

I. Made and entered into between:

Hereinafter referred to as the CONTESTANT, hometown and country, record (Fight Fax copy attached)

II. Both parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The CONTESTANT agrees to participate in a contest:

2. The ORGANIZER shall pay to the CONTESTANT (amount to be paid) \$ 60 000 USD less expenses for licence or sanction fee, if applicable, as full and final payment for services rendered as provided herein. The parties agree that they may not assign or transfer in whole or in part the rights and obligations contained in this contract. However, the ORGANIZER shall deduct 20% from the amount of the purse paid to the CONTESTANT and remit the amount deducted to his opponent if the CONTESTANT's weight exceeds what is stipulated at article II.1

3. The ORGANIZER agree not to request from the CONTESTANT any money for whatsoever reasons and not to deduct from the purse, any expenses made for the CONTESTANT, other than the cases provided for in the article II.2.

4. The ORGANIZER will reimburse the CONTESTANT's travelling expenses and pay him N/A % of the amount provided for in clause II.2, where the CONTESTANT is present at the official weight-in and his opponent or the substitute opponent cannot fight as schedule.

5. Where he is unable to participate in the program of the sports event for medical reasons, the CONTESTANT agrees to provide a certificate to that effect and undergo a medical examination by a physician designated by the R.A.C.J.

6. Where the opponent is unable, for any reason whatsoever, to fight on the day of the program of the sports event, the CONTESTANT agrees to fight a substitute opponent chosen by both parties and authorized by the R.A.C.J. no later than 24 hours before the beginning of the first bout schedules on the program.

7. The Parties reserve the right to terminate this agreement at any time for all legal purposes where:

- the parties so consent in writing
- the CONTESTANT is declared unfit to fight as a result of the medical examinations required under subparagraphs 2 and 3 of the first paragraph of section 159 of the regulation respecting combat sports
- if the CONTESTANT is disqualified after being tested positive on an anti-doping control test, refuse or neglect to take the said control as stipulated in the section 148.1 of the Act respecting safety in sports (R.S.Q., c. S-3.1)
- either of the parties commits a serious breach of any of his obligations under this agreement or
- it is impossible for one of the parties to accomplish the object of this agreement.
- the event is officially cancelled.

8. The CONTESTANT agrees to not use any banned substances or drugs and to obey any request by the R.A.C.J. to undertake an anti doping control tests.

9. The ORGANIZER and CONTESTANT agree to conduct themselves, this promotion and this contest in accordance with the provisions of the ACT RESPECTING SAFETY IN SPORTS (R.S.Q., c. S-3.1) and the regulations made thereunder governed by the "REGIE DES ALCOOL, DES COURSES ET DES JEUX DU QUEBEC" (R.A.C.J.). ORGANIZER and CONTESTANT understand and agree that failure to do so may result in the withholding of the purse, suspension or revocation of license the assessment of a fine or such other penalties as the R.A.C.J. may impose as provided by law.

CONTESTANT must provide medical tests (HIV, Hepatitis A, B, C and EEG). No publicity, on corner peoples, CONTESTANT's clothes or skin is allowed, without prior consent by ORGANIZER. Failure to comply will result in cancellation of the match.

The refundable amount of \$5,000 will be paid on the signature of the agreement. A bank draft of the remains \$54,000, less applicable sanction fees and taxes, will be given to the IBF Supervisor, the day of the official weighing.
